

Mystery Quilt STEP FOUR

You have trimmed your 64 blocks so they are all the same size.

ARRANGE your blocks into eight rows of eight blocks as shown in the diagram or choose your own arrangement. You may want to research layouts for Half-square Triangles to get your juices flowing.

Sew together into rows. **Press** the seams of each row in **opposite** directions. **Sew** the rows together and **Press** seams.

BORDER

Cut four strips 3" by WOF (Width of Fabric). **Sew** two strips end to end, right sides together. **Make two**. **Measure** the quilt top in the **center from top to bottom**. **Cut** the two strips to this measurement. **Sew** one border onto each side of the quilt top. **Press** seams out.

Cut five strips 7" by WOF. **Sew** strips end to end, right sides together to make one long strip. **Measure** the quilt top in the **center from left to right**. **Cut** two strips to this measurement. **Sew** one onto the top and bottom of the quilt top. **Press** seams out.

Layer and quilt as desired.

BINDING

Cut binding fabric into eight strips 2-1/2" (NOTE: I use 2-1/4" wide) wide by WOF. **Sew** binding strips end to end, right sides together. **Press** in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. **Continue** your binding as usual.

Make a label for your quilt. This quilt pattern is RIPPLES by Elisa Wilson of Elisa's Backporch Design and your MYSTERY QUILT 2017.
